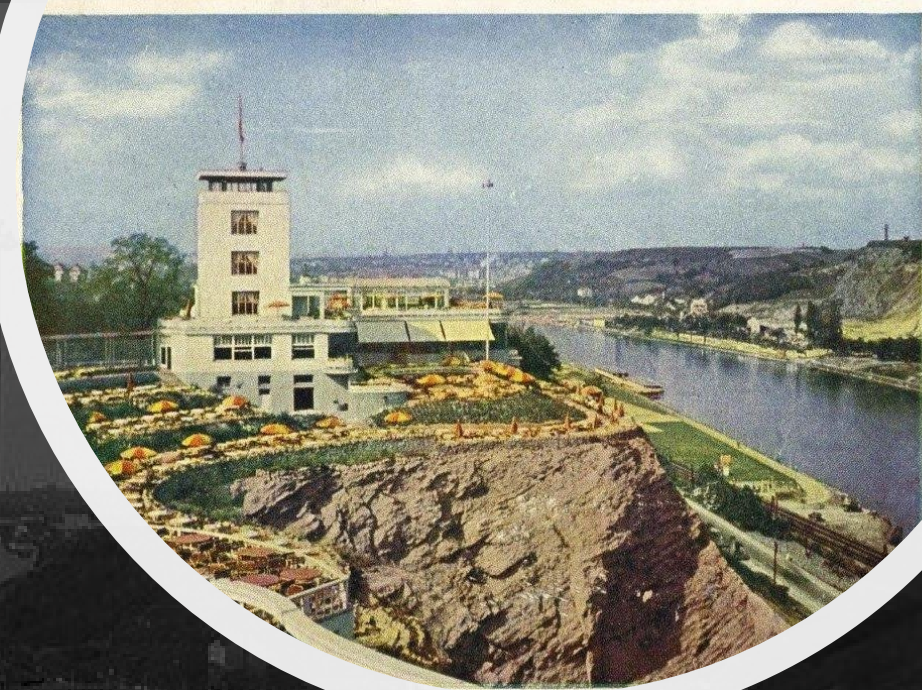

Barrandovské terasy

- Horní areál s restaurací byl otevřen v září roku 1929.
- *The upper part with a restaurant was opened in September 1929.*
- Dolní areál s bazénem byl otevřen 16. srpna roku 1930.
- *The lower part with a swimming pool was opened on 16th August 1930.*

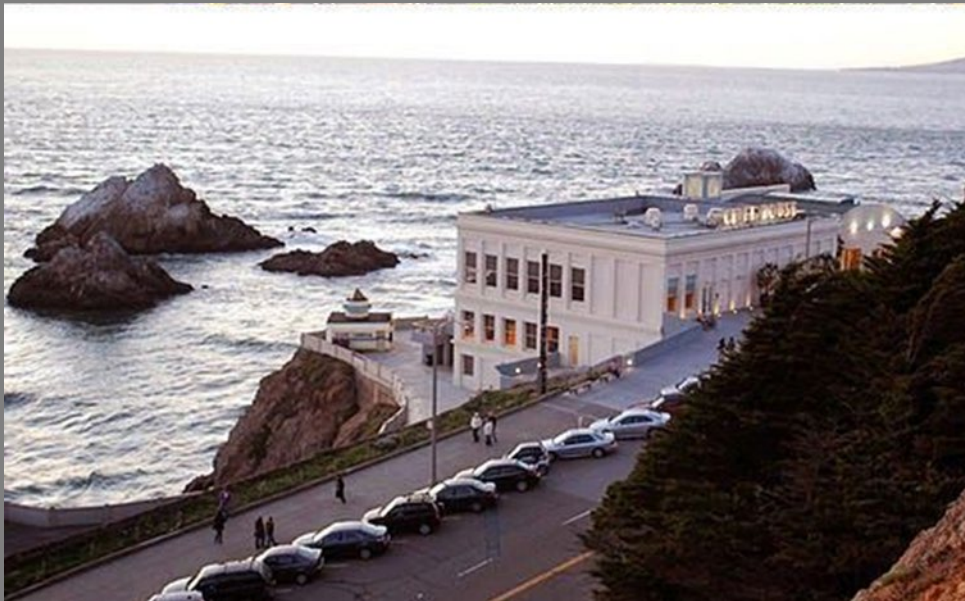


- Pod Terasami Barrandov, Hlubočepy, Praha.
- Slogan: „Za Prahou a přece v Praze“.
- *The slogan: “Outside of Prague but still in Prague”.*
- Měla to být ikona města.
- *It was supposed to be an icon on the city.*





- Stavbu realizoval otec Václava Havla, bývalý prezident republiky, a architektem byl Václav Kolátor a Max Urban.
- *The building was designed by the father of Václav Havel, former president of the CZE, and the architects were Václav Kolátor and Max Urban.*



- Byl inspirován Cliff Housem v Kalifornii.
- *It was inspired by the Cliff House in California.*

- Britský novinář Sydney Morrell (1938) řekl, že „Češi pod širým nebem postavili nejkrásnější restauraci v Evropě s bazénem v bývalém lomu“.
- *British journalist Sydney Morrell (1938) said: “Czechs have built the most beautiful open air restaurant in Europe with a swimming pool in a former quarry.”*



- První den přišlo více než 50 000 návštěvníků.
- *The first day that the area was opened came in more than 50 000 visitors.*
- Otevřeno bylo non-stop a to 365 dní v roce, až do roku obsazení českých zemí německou armádou v roce 1939.
- *It was opened non-stop for 365 days a year. Until the year 1939 when the country was occupied by german army.*





- Nacisté nechali postavit nad Terasy přímou železnici, která tam dovážela hosty.
- *The Nazis had built straight railway to Terasy which imported the guests.*

- Wehrmacht je využil jako pozorovatelnu a lokalizaci protiletectvé obrany.
- *Wehrmacht had used them as loophole and localization for anti-aircraft defences.*

- Po válce se do Teras neinvestovalo, a tak postupně začaly chátrat.
- *After the war people didn't invest money in it and it started to fall into ruins.*
- Bazén byl uzavřen dříve než restaurace a to v roce 1955.
- *The swimming pool was closed even before the restaurant, in 1955.*
- V roce 1982 byl zavřen i bar Trilobit.
- *In 1982 the Trilobit bar was closed.*





- V roce 1988 byl celý areál prohlášen za kulturní památkou a v roce 1993 památkovou zónou.
- *In 1988 the whole area was declared a culture monument and in 1993 a historical zone.*



- Roku 2001 bar Trilobit vyhořel.
- *In 2001 the Trilobit bar burnt out.*
- Majitelem horní části je společnost Barrandovské terasy a.s.
- *Nowadays the owner of the upper part is the company Barrandovské terasy a.s.*

- Na jaře roku 2018 zahájila opravu své části komplexu.
- *In spring 2018 the company has began repairing their part.*
- Vlastníkem dolní části je Dagmar Havlová, získala ji od svého manžela Václava Havla.
- *The owner of the lower part is Dagmar Havlová, she received it from her husband Václav Havel.*
- S opravou dolní části nepočítá.
- *She isn't going to repair the lower part.*
